**RE: CAPILANO SUSPENSION BRIDGE FUNDRAISER – MAY 12, 2007**

All Members,

It's held royalty, rock stars, and recently a 46-ton tree and on Saturday, May 12, 2007, Capilano Suspension Bridge will hold an unprecedented number of Professional Fire Fighters, their families and friends in a fundraising effort for the Burn Fund.

Both organizations were affected during the winter storms of 2006. Capilano Suspension Bridge closed for repairs after a windstorm swept through the park causing extensive damage, resulting in the cancellation of the annual Canyon Lights celebration. For the BC Professional Fire Fighters' Burn Fund, the storms lead to a four-day cancellation of the popular Bright Nights in Stanley Park event, which presented a challenge in meeting our fundraising goals.

Besides physically supporting hundreds of Professional Fire Fighters, Capilano Suspension Bridge will also make a donation to the Burn Fund to help raise funds for essential programs which support burn survivors and their families, upgrade and educate Burn Unit medical staff, and support world-renowned burn and wound healing research in B.C.
